Ready for School?

Greetings from the newbie downstairs—I am so excited to join the LCL team! I have had a blast my first few weeks at Licking County Library getting to know patrons big and small—I can't wait to meet you all as time goes on! I come to LCL with a background in Early Literacy focusing on ages 0-5, and I look forward to sharing tools and resources to help you and your children get ready for Kindergarten and beyond!

Do you know the best tool at your disposal to help get your child ready to start school? It's not a fancy app or gadget, it's not a live-in nanny, and it's not a private preschool. I'll give you a hint...it's wearing your clothes. It's YOU! You are your child's first teacher, and I want to empower you to embrace that role with confidence! You know your child better than anyone else in this world—you know what they're interested in, and you communicate with them more effectively than I or anyone else ever could.

Do you find yourself wondering if you're doing the "right things" to get your child ready for school? Allow me to reassure you—it's easier than you think. Over the next few months, I'm going to share with you six early literacy skills that will help get your child ready to start school, as well as five simple practices you already do *every day* that, with a little tweaking, will provide your little one with a strong foundation for their Kindergarten teacher to build on when the time comes.

The first of those six early literacy skills is so easy to work on with your child that I'm almost certain you're already doing it most days. Print motivation is a child's interest in and enjoyment of books. Plainly said, the goal is to get your child to love reading! So read with your kid(s) every day, and make it fun. Never use reading as or associate reading with discipline. Never force your child to sit still for a book—if your toddler wants to play with trains while you read a book, so be it. As long as they're enjoying the experience, that's all that matters. They're still soaking in that story and all those luscious vocabulary words while they're playing. And don't forget to take advantage of those times during the day that naturally lend themselves to reading like naptime, bedtime, and "captive" times like when your child is eating. I used to read to my daughter every morning while she ate her breakfast. And for a parenting level up, keep books in the bathroom and make potty training time reading time…because sometimes it can take a while, am I right?

If you'd like some benchmarks to make sure your child is "on track" with their early literacy skills, check out the Early Literacy Milestone chart, available in English and Spanish at www. reachoutandread.org/resource-center/literacy-materials/literacy-milestones/. Or, just stop by the Youth Services desk—we have some printed out and ready to go home with you! I think if you see what your child is "supposed" to be able to do, you'll know that you are fully equipped for your first "teaching job!"
